

What is hoopla?

Hoopla provides access to eBooks, audiobooks, comics, music, movies, and TV. With hoopla and your valid Lincolnwood Library card, you can borrow, instantly stream, and download content via hoopla's mobile app or hoopladigital.com. The desktop and mobile app versions are so different we have guides for each!

How to Create an Account – Desk/laptop

- 1. To access hoopla, simply go to hoopladigital.com online.
- 2. Select the blue Get Started button. Select Let's Go!
- 3. Type Lincolnwood in the **Search for your library** box, select **Lincolnwood Public Library**, and select **Next**.
- 4. Enter your **21242000XXXXXX** library card number and select **Next**.
- 5. Enter your <u>address@service.com</u> email address and set a password for your account. Select **Complete Registration**.

Must be 8 to 40 characters long

You may need to open up your email to confirm your account.

If you do not immediately see the email from hoopla, try checking **Junk**, **Spam**, **Promotions**, and/or **Updates** folders.

Follow the instructions in the email, which may tell you to click a link which will direct you back to hoopla to confirm the account.


Navigating Hoopla

At the top of the home page you will find several drop down menus. Select **My Hoopla** and then **Currently Borrowed** to see how many more items you can borrow this month.



The **Browse** menu allows you to see the various titles Hoopla has in its collection in 7 categories: audiobooks, movies, music, comic, eBooks, television, and BingePasses.


You can browse each section by selecting from the *Popular*, *Featured*, *Recommended* and other lists. Select **See More** by any section to see even more of that category in a grid view.

If you know the title you're searching for, you may type it in the **search bar**. From the dropdown menu to the left you may filter your search results by category:

- Audiobooks
- Comics
- Ebooks
- Movies
- Music
- Television each episode =1 borrow
- BingePasses
- · Author/People
- Categories (subject)
- Publisher
- Series




Borrowing and accessing items Borrowing

When you've found the title you want to check out, select its cover to go to its page. You can see more information to be sure you want to borrow it. Select **Borrow**. In the confirmation menu that appears, select **Borrow Title**. All titles are always available – there is never a need to place a hold in hoopla.








To access your borrowed titles, click **My Hoopla**, then **Currently Borrowed**.

Accessing items

From Currently Borrowed items, click any to start listening, reading, or playing them. Comics have text bubble icons, TV and





movies have camera icons, music has notes icons, and ebooks have a book icon. Select any title and then Read or Play buttons on their pages to start enjoying them!

Borrowing Limits

You may check out up to 12 items every month with no late fees. Expired items are no longer be available on your account.

Audiobooks - 21 days

eBooks and Comics - 21 days

Music Titles - 7 days

Movies and TV Shows - 72 hours or 3 days

Renewals

The option to renew a title appears 1 day before the end of the borrowing period on the item page. Please note that a renewal is the same as a new borrow, so a renewed title will count against your monthly limit.


Your Hoopla Settings

Select the gear icon to see **Settings** to customize your Hoopla experience.




Select from the **Account**, **Library**, **Recommendations**, **Email**, and **Password** tabs to see and customize different settings.

Settings



The account menu allows you to opt in or out of emails from Hoopla that notify users of new content and features. Turning on Kids mode allows you to only see child-appropriate content in your browse and search results. You can also disable the borrowing history.


You can sign up to receive book recommendations in the **Recommendations** menu.

Finally, you can change your account email and password in the **E-mail** and **Password** menus.

Kids Mode

Once you've turned **Kids Mode** on in **Settings**, select the Hoopla logo to browse only titles good for kids.

hoopla Kids Mode

A kid friendly setting for finding videos, music, and books.

You can also at any time turn Kids Mode on/off by pressing the Kids button in the upper left corner near **Settings** and **Search**.



- Kids Mode is Off, select this to turn it on.



- Kids Mode is On, select this to turn it off.




How to Create an Account

 To access hoopla on your mobile device, download the Hoopla Digital app from your mobile app store. It is available on both Apple and Android devices.




- 2. Once the app is downloaded, tap the icon to open the app.
- 3. Tap "Don't have an account? Sign Up" to make an account.





- 4. Enter your email address and set a password for your account. Click **Next**.
- 5. On the following screen type in **Lincolnwood** and select **Lincolnwood Public Library** from the list. Select **Agree**.
- Enter your Lincolnwood Library card number and click Next.

Personal Settings allows you to change your account email & password.

Library Settings lets you to update the library to which your account is linked.

Notification Settings lets you enable / disable device notifications.


Link a Streaming Device allows you to connect TVs and other devices to your account.

Navigating Hoopla


The **Video**, **Books**, and **More** menus allow you to browse Hoopla's collection in each one of those categories.

The **Video** menu allows you to toggle between **Movies** and **Television** to select feature films or television shows for checkout. More includes **Music** and unlimited **BingePasses**.



The **Books** menu allows you to toggle between **Audiobooks**, **eBooks**, and **Comics**.



The **Video**, **Music**, and **Books** menus allow you to browse items by **Genre**. Scroll down to find and then select the **Genres** button. A menu appears from which you can select a specific curated **Collections** or **Genres**, to narrow down your search.



To search for a specific item, tap the **Search** tab, press the text box, type in names/keywords of the item you're looking for and select **Search**.

The **My Hoopla** menu lets you see favorites, borrowed items, and history.



Borrowing and accessing items

When you've found the title you want to check out, tap the title's image and you'll be taken to a page with a summary of the item and a blue Borrow button. Tap Borrow. To access your borrowed titles, tap the My hoopla tab at the bottom of the screen. Your Borrowed

items will be at the top.




Ebooks and comics must be downloaded to be read. After borrowing them, go back to their page and press Download. You can also download movie/TV titles to avoid streaming when watching. Press Download to your device on their pages.

Download to your device.

You can stream music, audiobooks, movies, and TV show episodes without download. To do this, go to My hoopla > Borrowed. Then press the item image and press read or play.



Favorite Items


See something you like but aren't ready to borrow it? You can **Favorite** an item by clicking the con. To see all the items you've favorited, go to **My hoopla** and select **Favorites**.





Kids Mode

You can turn on Kids Mode in settings, and you can also access it from My hoopla. Press the KIDS button and make sure it says ON. To turn Kids mode off, press the KIDS button again and it will say OFF.
