



Virtual Reality Viewers instructions

1. Take smartphones out of any case.
2. Insert headphones into the smartphone (if desired).
3. Open the viewer headset from the top.
4. Insert smartphone, make sure the fit is secure in the center.
5. Open a VR app (see Example VR apps).
6. In the app, find the specific content you want to experience in VR, then press the cardboard button.

1. Close the viewer
2. Put the viewer over your eyes and pull the straps around your head.
3. Adjust the straps one at a time to ensure a comfortable fit.
4. Move the slider above the middle of your forehead left/right to focus. Move the lower left slider to adjust the distance between the lenses.
5. Some apps support actions while in VR. Press the gray button on the top right of the viewer to do those actions.
6. Enjoy your VR content.



This is the button you have to press.

- 4.5" to 6" smartphones with accelerometer and gyroscopes.
