

Xbox One Controller instructions

Connecting the controller

- 1. Turn on your Xbox One console.
- 2. Insert either AA batteries or rechargeable batteries into the controller. Use the included Micro USB charger and wall block to charge the controller.
- 3. Turn on the controller by pressing and holding the Xbox button. It will flash.
- 4. Press and release the Pair button on the Xbox console. This button may be located in different places depending on the specific version of Xbox console you have.
- 5. Also press and hold the controllers Pair button on the top middle of the Library Xbox controller until the controllers Xbox button flashes a few times. This means it is searching for consoles.



This is the Pair button. It may be shaped differently on some other consoles, but it should have three >>> characters to let you know you've found it.

When the Xbox button on the controller stays lit, the controller has connected to the Xbox console.

Controllers are assigned to users based on who is holding the controller. Learn more about <u>Assigning Controller Profiles</u>.
